## PROPOSAL (SECTION 50)

### IN THE MATTER OF THE PROPOSAL OF

Cassis on the 17 INC.

I, Cassis on the 17 INC.. (hereinafter referred to as the "**Debtor**" or "**Cassis**" or the "**Company**"), being an insolvent corporation, hereby submit the following proposal to my creditors under the Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act (the "**Act**"):

#### 1. **Purpose and background of the Proposal**

The purpose of the Proposal is to restructure the financial affairs of the Company in order to provide its creditors with the best available opportunity to recover the funds owed to them. The Proposal will allow creditors of Cassis to achieve a recovery on their claims that is greater than what the creditors could expect if the Company were to file for bankruptcy.

Passion has suffered a cash flow shortage and is in the process of restructuring its management processes and working capacity to allow it to remain a viable, operating business into the future, and is filing a Proposal to avoid filing bankruptcy.

#### 2. **Certain Crown Claims**

The Debtor shall remit payment directly to the Canada Revenue Agency ("**CRA**"), for the claim of His Majesty in right of Canada or a province for amounts pursuant to Section 60(1.1) of the Act that could be subject to demand under:

- Subsection 224(1.2) of the *Income Tax Act*;
- Any provision of the *Canada Pension Plan* or of the *Employment Insurance Act* that refers to subsection 224(1.2) of the *Income Tax Act*; and
- Any provision of provincial legislation that has a similar purpose to subsection 224(1.2) of the *Income Tax Act*.

The Debtor is seeking to make 36 monthly payments of \$3,600 per month, for a total of \$129,600 (the "**CRA Property Payment**") in order to satisfy the requirement pursuant to Section 60 (1.1) of the Act. CRA would be entitled to file as an unsecured creditor for any remaining balance outstanding. The payments are to commence upon creditor approval of the proposal.

All obligations of Cassis to CRA, arising subsequent to the date of the filing of the Proposal for source deductions, GST and other amounts required to be withheld by the Debtor on behalf of CRA, shall be paid in full as they become due.

3. **Secured Claims**

The Trustee is unaware of any secured creditors at the date of filing the Proposal.

4. **Proposal to Preferred and other Priority Claims**

The claims of all preferred creditors if any, as accepted by the Trustee, shall be paid in full without interest or penalty, in priority of the claims of other creditors, to the extent provided for in section 136 of the Act.

All administrative fees and expenses incurred in relation to the proceedings leading to the filing of this Proposal and in connection with the preparation of this Proposal and the administration of this Proposal, will be paid in priority to the claims of unsecured creditors.

5. **Proposal to Unsecured Creditors**

Upon the filing of the Proposal the Debtor remitted a payment to the Trustee of \$5,000.

Within 30 days of the filing of the Proposal the Debtor shall make a further payment of \$5,000.

The Debtor shall make 60 payments of \$500. per month to the Trustee, commencing in the month following Creditor approval of the proposal.

The total amount payable under this proposal is \$40,000.

The Trustee will deposit all payments made by the Debtor to the Trustee in a trust account to be distributed in accordance with the terms of this proposal (hereinafter referred to as the "Fund").

Upon payment to the Trustee of the amounts specified in the paragraph, the Debtor shall be deemed to have satisfied the claims of her unsecured creditors in full.

6. **Distribution to Unsecured Creditors**

Claims of unsecured creditors, as accepted by the Trustee, shall be paid pro-rata from the remaining monies in the Fund after the payments referred to in paragraphs 3, 4 and 5 have been provided for.

The Trustee shall make a distribution to the unsecured creditors of the Debtor in accordance with the terms of this Proposal from the Fund annually and upon

completion of this Proposal by the Debtor, or such other interval as approved by the inspectors appointed pursuant to the terms of this Proposal, or if no inspectors are appointed, such other interval as deemed appropriate by the Trustee.

The Debtor reserves the right to payout the full amount of this Proposal at any time without penalty.

7. **Trustee**

Hudson & Company Insolvency Trustees Inc. (the "Trustee") shall be the Trustee under this proposal and all monies payable under this proposal shall be paid to the Trustee, whose address is #200, 625 – 11<sup>th</sup> Ave. S.W., Calgary, Alberta, who shall distribute all such payments to creditors in accordance with the terms of this proposal.

8. **Fees and Expenses**

Provision for payment of all proper fees and expenses of the Trustee and the legal fees and disbursements of the Trustee, before, on and incidental to the proceedings arising out of this proposal shall be made in full out of the Fund and shall be made in priority to all preferred and unsecured creditors

9. **Release of Director Liability**

The acceptance of the Proposal by the creditors shall release indefinitely, as at the filing of the Proposal, the Debtors' director in accordance with Section 50(13) on the Act, from any and all liability or obligation for which they may be liable by law in their capacity as directors in respect of any debt of the Debtor which arose before the filing of the Proposal. It is understood however that nothing herein shall be interpreted as an acknowledgement of any liability or obligation on the part of the director as at the filing of the Proposal.

10. **Inspectors**

At the statutory meeting of creditors to be held to consider this proposal, the creditors may appoint one or more, but not exceeding five, inspectors under the terms of this proposal whose powers shall be restricted to:

- a. advising the Trustee in respect of such matters as may be referred to the inspectors by the Trustee;

- b. advising the Trustee concerning any dispute that may arise as to the validity of claims of preferred and unsecured creditors under this Proposal; and
- c. exercising all the powers given to inspectors of a bankrupt estate appointed pursuant to the provisions of the Act.

11. **Waiver of Default**

Upon acceptance of this proposal by the creditors, the inspectors, if appointed, may waive any default in the performance of any provision of this proposal, provided that such default is remedied within 30 days of the date the provision was to have been performed, and further, if no inspectors are appointed, the creditors delegate to the Trustee upon approval of the proposal the power to act on their behalf and waive any default in the performance of any provision of this proposal, provided that such default is remedied within 30 days of the date the provision was to have been performed.

On completion of this proposal, the creditors agree to notify any credit reporting agency that their claims have been satisfied. They further authorize the Trustee to notify any credit reporting agencies that all claims against them under this proposal have been satisfied.

In accordance with Section 50 (2)(b) of the Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act, I submit herewith a summary of my financial position to the date hereof, verified by affidavit as being correct to the best of my knowledge and belief.


